## Banquet policies

---

### ACCESSIBILITY AND ASSIGNMENT

You can access the room assigned to you starting at 5:00 p.m. on the day of the event. The hotel will decide where the ceremony and/or cocktail party will be held, with no guarantees. (Charges apply if you would like to reserve a specific location.) One week before the event, the hotel will confirm at what time the supplier (orchestra/mobile disco) can set up. In case of major need (fire, serious damage, strikes, etc.), the hotel manager reserves the exclusive right to substitute the reception rooms herein described for other rooms that are as appropriate.

### FOOD AND ALCOHOL

In compliance with the regulations enforced by the RACJ, at no time will alcohol or food not sold by Château Bonne Entente be allowed inside the hotel or on the site. Moreover, Château Bonne Entente reserves the right to stop serving alcoholic beverages to clients we feel are inebriated.

### DEPOSIT AND PAYMENT

A first (non-refundable) deposit of \$1,000 is required two weeks after signing the contract. A second deposit of \$1,500 is required 2 months before the wedding. A third deposit, equal to 75% of the total estimated cost is required fifteen (15) days before the event. The balance must be paid on the day of the wedding by debit card, credit card or cheque. The amounts will be cut in half for smaller weddings (64 people or less).

### DELIVERY

You can bring your advisor any decorations, favours and other articles between 9:00 a.m. and 4:00 p.m. on the day before the event. These must be dropped off at the executive office. We are not responsible for articles delivered outside of these hours. We can place your favours and/or centerpiece on the day of the wedding.

### GUARANTEED MINIMUM

The client agrees to inform the hotel of the number of expected guests 15 days before the reception. This number cannot be below the guaranteed minimum and will become the new guaranteed minimum. Furthermore, the hotel agrees to prepare 5% more place settings than the number of confirmed guests.

### MUSIC / END OF THE EVENING

Please note that the evening must end at the latest 1:30 a.m. (including music, bar and dancing). Château Bonne Entente reserves the right to lower the music at midnight.

### PRICE

All prices hereby indicated are subject to change without notice. Added to these amounts are the applicable federal and provincial taxes as well as service charges (15%).

### SOCAN

Charges (between \$ 20.56 and \$59.17) apply for all music played in a public area by musicians and/or mobile discos that did not write or compose the performed work under article 50, paragraph 8 of the Copyright Act (SOCAN).

### TOBACCO ACT

The Château Bonne Entente is proud to offer a smoke-free environment (including all the rooms). In accordance with the Law on smoking, cigarette smoking is authorized outside the establishment, that is to say, within 9 metres of the doors.
