OUR "ECO-RESPONSIBLE" PROGRAM ..

- Sorting your recyclable materials (paper, cardboard, plastic, metals and glass) at the source, in your meeting room.
- Sorting of organic materials generated by meal preparation and service at the source, in the kitchen.
- Using sustainable products such as re-usable dishes, glasses and utensils.
- Cuisine exempt of MSG (monosodium glutamate).
- Seating on chairs covered with a fabric made of a 100% recycled nylon fibre in Quebec.
- Using 100% post-consumer recycled paper for photocopies.
- Using sugar bowls and milk/cream pitchers instead of individual packets.
- Using pitchers of water rather than bottles.
- Offering a choice of menus that put the accent on products from Quebec and the creativity of our culinary team.
- Serving fair-trade organic coffee.
- Offering fair-trade wine.
- Providing teleconferencing services.
- Suggesting the Save the Planet program to all participants.

OUR "À LA CARTE" SUPPLEMENTS ..

- Recovering participants' name badges, coroplast signs and other used materials like wood, metal, etc.
- Using fair-trade flowers.
- Orchestrating car-pooling for participants thanks to a partnership with Amigo-Express or the Réseau de Covoiturage.
- Suggesting that the addition of presentations on the various aspects of the environmental challenge through the Agence de Conférenciers Terre à terre speakers' bureau.
- Calculating greenhouse gases and compensating for GHGs through purchasing carbon credits or planting trees thanks to a partnership with Unisfera and Planétair, its compensatory credit program.
- Collecting food surpluses from your event to food banks in the region.
- Your event certified by BNQ (Bureau de Normalisation du Québec). Our partner "Takt Etik" will guide you.
